Generating Images with ChatGPT

- Creating images from text prompts
- Specifying art style, lighting, and color palette
- Refining generated images
- Generating images in a similar photographic style

Generating Images with Adobe Firefly

- Creating images in Adobe Firefly
- Choosing Firefly models and image settings
- Generating images with a similar style

Changing Images & Removing Elements

- Using AI generators such as ChatGPT or Adobe Firefly, versus working inside Photoshop
- Removing objects and making minor or major changes to images

AI Features in Adobe Photoshop

- Remove unwanted objects such as products, wires, cables, and people
- Understand AI resolution limitations
- Increase image resolution with AI upscaling tools
- Create AI-powered selections with Select Subject, Select People, and Object Selection
- Use Harmonize to blend objects naturally into scenes
- Rotate objects in 3D space with AI-powered object rotation

AI Features in Adobe Illustrator

- Generate vector graphics, scenes, subjects, and icons with AI
- Use partner AI models such as Firefly, Ideogram, and Gemini Nano Banana
- Generate repeating patterns with AI
- Recolor artwork using text prompts with Generative Recolor
- Experiment with prompts, detail settings, and AI-generated variations

AI Features in Adobe InDesign

- Apply and generate Style Packs with AI
- Generate images directly inside layouts
- Know when to use Photoshop instead for higher resolution or more control

Non-Visual Uses for AI

- Research, writing, and inspiration
- Reviewing and improving content

Using AI to Build Custom Automations

- Automating repetitive design workflows
- Understanding how and why AI can help designers write code (without them having to understand the code)
- Using AI to create scripts for Adobe apps
