- Calculate per diem, transportation allowances, and reimbursable expenses.
- Learn about house-hunting trips, temporary quarters, subsistence expenses, and household goods movement.
- Explore regulations for shipping and storing privately owned vehicles (POVs).
- Address relocation income tax allowances and miscellaneous expense allowances.
