Premiere Pro Bootcamp

You'll learn how to shape footage on the timeline, sync and polish audio, correct color, and export professional videos for multiple platforms, making this course a strong fit for beginners or anyone refining their post-production workflow.

- Edit and assemble video and audio using streamlined post-production workflows
- Reduce background noise and balance audio levels for clearer sound
- Color correct footage and use adjustment layers for consistent visuals
- Add B-roll, photos, logos, titles, and transitions to elevate storytelling

- Control pacing with speed changes, slow motion, and freeze frames
- Cut multi-camera footage and remove green screens with chroma keying
- Resize and format videos for social platforms, including square outputs
- Bring After Effects projects into Premiere Pro and export finished videos for sharing or client delivery

After Effects Compositing, Tracking, & Keying

Master advanced compositing techniques in After Effects, including keying, rotoscoping, and motion tracking. This course teaches you how to seamlessly integrate 2D and 3D elements into your video projects.

- Use motion tracking with Point Tracker and MochaAE to match movement with precision.
- Remove backgrounds with green screen keying using the Keylight effect and garbage mattes.
- Stabilize shaky footage with the Warp Stabilizer VFX tool for smooth motion.
- Apply time remapping techniques to create slow-motion, fast-motion, and frame-blended effects.
- Rotoscope video footage using manual techniques and the Roto Brush tool.
- Work with track mattes to create complex layering effects with images and video.

- Work with 3D layers, cameras, and lights to create dynamic scenes

- Create and animate custom shape layers using the Pen tool
- Develop advanced text animations and save presets for future use
- Optimize animations with expressions and wire parameters for complexity
- Enhance audio integration by adding markers and applying audio effects

- Create a professional video editing and motion graphics project by developing a concept, visual direction, and production plan based on real-world design challenges and personal creative interests.
- Build supporting materials—including a project plan, moodboard, style frames, and storyboard—to guide your editing and animation process and align your work with a consistent visual style and tone.
- Produce an animatic to preview the pacing and structure of your final video, then bring your concept to life using Adobe Premiere Pro and Adobe After Effects to edit, animate, and composite a polished final piece.
- Work on your capstone project both in and outside of class, using scheduled mentoring sessions to review your progress, ask questions, and get personalized feedback from your instructor as you finalize your project for your professional portfolio.
