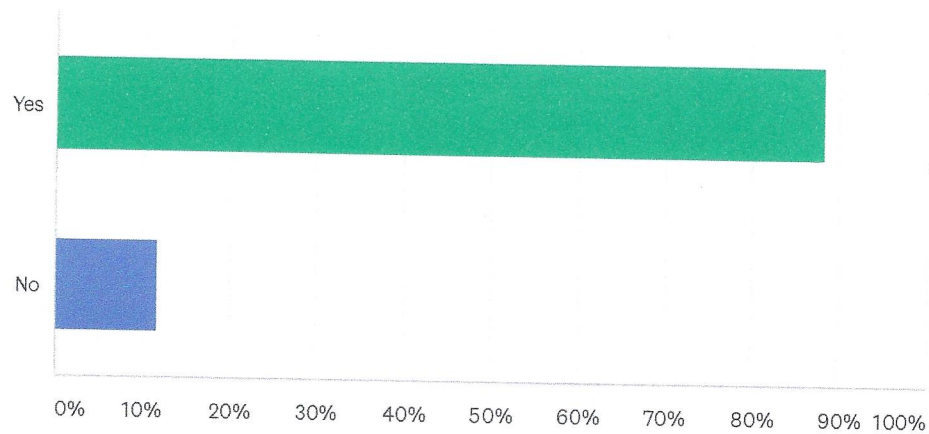


Q1 After the COVID-19 pandemic and Federal employees are permitted to return to their offices, are you willing to teach a face-to-face class?

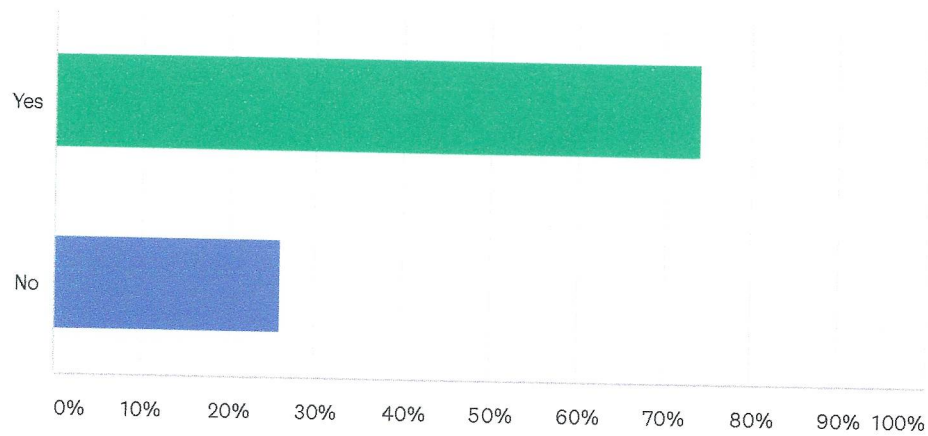

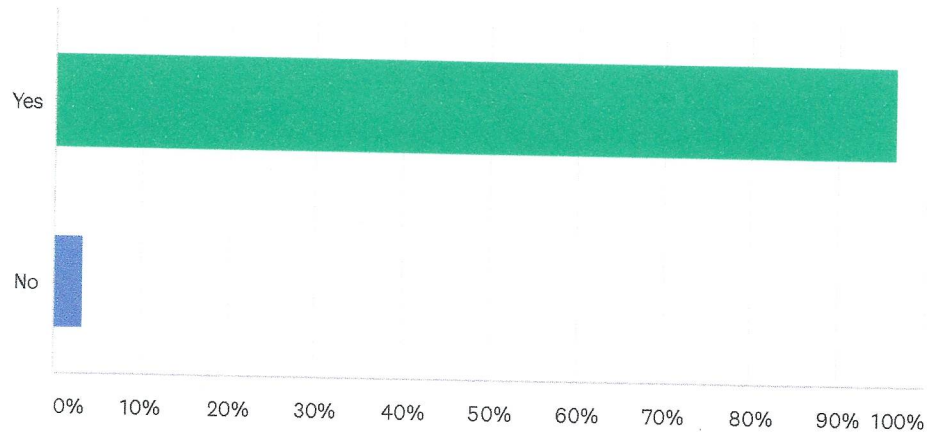
